History of the Playground

The Playground was established back in 1940. Back then housewives and their children used to meet here. In 1970 some workmen's huts were placed on the location and two staff members were hired to look after the place. Later in 1998 a roomy house was build in the playground along with a large sandpit. A lot of new toys were added to the playground as well. A part of the playground was covered with asphalt and a miniature roadway was installed. The traffic is directed by a traffic light. Latest in 2009 a big climbing frame was added to the playground facilities.

What Possibilities does the Playground offer?

The playground is intended to be a place where children, youngsters and adults can meet, play and have fun together.

From the early spring bicycles and moon-cars are displayed for free disposition. In the wintertime these toys are packed away and the playground offers a lot of different indoor activities instead. It might be activities like working with clay, fabric, pearls, paper, plaster etc.

All year the children are allowed to use the playground's bikeshop if their own or somebody else's bicycle needs repairing or maintenance.

It is also possible to celebrate birthdays in the playground in between opening hours. It is necessary though, to make an appointment with the playground staff in good time before the event.

In corporation with the municipality of Lyngby-Taarbæk and the local police department the playground is also used for testing the childrens (kindergarten, 1.grade, third grade and fourth grade) ability to go and ride about the streets in safety.

The playground offers further activities during summertime and around Christmastime.

Practical information

The playgrounds opening hours:

Monday – Thursday: 10-17

Friday 10-16

NOTE: Time spent in the playground is always at your own risk.

A Playground staff member will always be present during opening hours and is available if any help should be needed.

Because the playground has a lot of visitors, it is necessary always to follow the rules of the playground, which are posted in the window next to the house entrance.

It is the responsibility of the adults to inform the children of the playground rules, especially if you are visiting for the first time.

The playground staff recommends that everyone is cleaning up after themselves and respects the rules that concern the use of the playground.

The playground is operated and administrated by the Technical Management, Operations.
